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Promoter's conditions

- 1. The competition will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing, and is licensed to Level 3 by Swim England.
- 2. Events will be as stated in the programme. Ages are as at midnight on the day of the competition.
- 3. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 4. Each swimmer will enter all five events and must not have achieved a time faster than ANY of the Cut Off times.
- 5. Entry times on the entry form must be given using 25m pool times (converted if appropriate).
- 6. No Time entries will be allowed, however these should be supplied with estimated times provided by the Club Coach and entered as custom times onto the Hy-Tek file.
- 7. The correct entry fee must accompany each entry form, or the entry will be treated as incorrect. Entry fees should be paid from a club in **one consolidated cheque**, made payable to CBHSC, or payment may be made by bank transfer, (Barclays Bank, Sort Code 20-87-94 and Account Number 60898813) but must be made within 7 days following the closing date.
- 8. The closing date is **Monday 26th February 2024** for entries made electronically by Hy-Tek file, and **Monday 19th February 2024** for paper entries. <u>All entry fees should be with CBHSC by Monday 4th March</u>.
- 9. Swimmers must be Club Compete Category members of the club in whose name they enter by the closing date for entries. The promoter may accept late entries at its discretion. No refunds will be made for incorrect entries.
- 10. The promoter reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries, and in the event of over-subscription, entries will be accepted on a **strictly first come, first served** basis, and any rejected swimmers will be refunded. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the closing date, except for a swimmer being selected to compete for their country or on production of a doctor's certificate.
- 11. In the event that a club's entries take the total number of entries over the time limit for the competition, such that it is not possible to accept all their entries, any deletions required from that club will be based on entry time for 50m Free, and balanced across each age group, with those swimmers losing entry to all five events. In such an event, those swimmers will receive a full refund.
- 12. Warm-up times and start times will be as stated in the programme for Session 1 and advised after close of entries for Session 2.
- 13. All events will be swum as heat declared winners; heats will be seeded in accordance with the submitted entry times, slowest to fastest. Heat start lists will be issued at the gala.
- 14. A secondary strobe is not available, but if the situation changes before the closing date of the meet, there will be a notice to that effect on the club website, and an updated meet pack will be published there showing this change of conditions.
- 15. Medals will be awarded at the end of the day based on total FINA points gained across all five events in each age group (9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over) boys and girls for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
- 16. Data Protection Carn Brea & Helston Swimming Club uses a computer to record entries and results. By submitting entries and accepting entry to the Open Meet, consent will be deemed to have been given for the holding of personal information on a computer, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018 and in line with GDPR 2018. Personal data recorded such as name, club, date of birth, and times entered and recorded may be made public during or after the Open Meet. This data will be passed to Swim England for the purpose of calculating and publishing swimmers' national rankings. Personal Data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoters.
- 17. No spectators will be allowed on poolside. Only competitors, appointed officials and holders of a valid Coach or Team Manager's pass will be permitted poolside. Clubs are reminded of Swim England's requirement that there should be one Team Manager on poolside for every 10 swimmers. The normal maximum of 5 poolside passes will therefore be overridden in the event that a club has more than 50 swimmers entering.

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18. There will be no cost for poolside passes on this occasion, but numbers, names and details of those applying must be submitted in advance. Coach packs will include programme and heat start sheets. Results will be sent to clubs by e-mail and will be available on the Carn Brea & Helston Swimming Club website, www.cbhsc.co.uk.

- 19. For advice and guidance on the use of recording or streaming devices during the duration of the completion parents should consult Swim England's Wavepower Policy: www.swimming.org/swimengland/wavepower-child-safeguarding-for-clubs. Anyone wishing to take images (photo or video) are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms.
- 20. In order to safeguard all athletes, no photography device is allowed to be used in the changing areas or toilets.
- 21. Team entries of more than 5 swimmers must be made electronically. The Hy-Tek Meet Manager file for Team Manager or Team Manager Lite is available from rosie@philipgordon.co.uk to whom electronic entries should also be made. Signed hard copies of entries must be retained by the submitting club for reference in the event of a query. Individual entries from clubs of less than 5 swimmers may be made by hard copy only, but must arrive by 12th February.
- 22. Competitors must report to the clerks of course two events before their own event. Competitors for the first two events of a session must report at the end of the warm-up.
- 23. Coaches and team managers should notify the recorders as soon as possible if any swimmer is unable to compete.
- 24. Para Swimmer Entries all swimmers must have an authorised SE/IPC swimming classification or Certificate of Exception or Certificate of Disability. In addition, details of disability, classification and exemptions must be provided with entry. Please ensure the Certificate of Exception or Certificate of Disability are presented to the Referee prior to each competition session, failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 25. Para swimmers: Please advise of any special requirements and we will do our best to meet them in consultation with their coaches. Medals will be awarded at the discretion of the Promoter.
- 26. Officials Requirement: To ensure that we comply with Licensing requirements, and that the Open Meet runs effectively and efficiently, all clubs submitting entries are requested to assist by supplying details of any licensed officials who are willing to help us. Their details must be entered on the Officials' Submission Form and be forwarded with their club's entries. Food and refreshments will be provided to officials who are on duty all day, and travel expenses will be offered to qualified officials attending this meet.
- 27. All valuables and clothing left in the changing rooms will be entirely at the owner's risk. Swimmers must not change on poolside, in the spectator area or spectators toilets. Swimmers must use the changing areas.
- 28. No diving at any time is permitted in the shallow end of the pool or in the warm down pool.
- 29. The pool is hired under agreements with the pool operators. As the pool is run primarily for the benefit of the public the temperature of the water and surrounding air is under the control of the pool operators. The water temperature is normally maintained above 28°C. No refunds will be given if a swimmer decides not to compete on the day based on water temperature, and a higher water temperature will not be a basis for a protest or complaint or legal action in the event of resulting harm.
- 30. Force majeure: In situations of force majeure or other unforeseen circumstances leading to the cancellation of the gala or part of the gala or other incomplete performance, CBHSC's liability will be restricted to a refund of a proportion of the entry fees to those affected for the affected events only after the Promoter has covered all incurred costs. The Club will communicate the circumstances to visiting clubs as soon as possible and seek to make alternative arrangements when this is reasonably feasible.
- 31. The Meet Promoter will make every effort to run the event at the advertised licence level. In any situation that the meet must be run at either unlicensed or at a lower licence level, competitors are not eligible for refunds of their entry fees.

Anything not covered by these conditions will be at the discretion of the Promoter, Phil Coad (chairman@cbhsc.co.uk) in agreement with the Meet Referee, (Julie Matraves) who reserves the right to alter these conditions in order to ensure the smooth running of the Meet. Any such alterations will be announced during the meet.
